Curriculum Design

The ambition of geography at Westfield is that all children have access to a thoroughly planned, progressive geography curriculum, which is taught through a variety of lessons.

The geography curriculum is bespoke to Westfield and includes topics which are relevant to the children and needs of the school. It has been designed so that all National Curriculum areas and skills are taught in a stimulating, fun and engaging way.

Geography aims to develop the children's understanding and knowledge of the world locally to them and of the wider world enabling them to develop a caring attitude towards the people, animals and plants within it.

Planning and sequencing

Progression statements are given for each year group, covering all expectations of the new national curriculum.

Skills are identified on the medium-term plans and show a progression of these skills through each year group, building on from one-year group to the next.

Pupils will build on locational knowledge, place knowledge, human and physical geography and geography skill and enquiry. They will deepen their knowledge of each of these aspects as they progress through the school.
