DEWA ROMAN EXPERIENCE

Dear Parent / Guardian

As part of our History Topic Year 3 will be visiting the Dewa Roman Experience in Chester on **Wednesday 4th March 2020**. This will consist of a fully guided tour of the reconstructions, excavations, museum and the award-winning 'hands-on room'. The topics that the children will cover are: Health, hygiene & medicine; Food and drink; Pottery; Archaeology and Roman artefacts.

The children will need to wear full school uniform including a pair of sensible walking shoes and a warm waterproof, outdoor coat.

If your child has a school dinner then a packed lunch will be provided, if they normally bring sandwiches from home they should do so as normal, in a plastic bag for easy disposal (no glass bottles please).

The cost of the trip is **£8.00** per child to cover the cost of the entrance fee, transport and insurance. If we do not receive enough payments as soon as possible we may be forced to cancel the trip. Payment also grants your child permission to attend the trip. Please note that the trip is subsidised by Pupil Premium Funding.
