Following our previous letter regarding the week full of fun activities for the Year 6 pupils, below are further details explaining the activities and the kit required:

Monday 24th June

A visit to Scotman's Flash. They will be kayaking, raft building and paddleboarding.

They will need the following kit:

- **Towel**
- **Swimsuit/swim costume (wear under clothing in the morning)**
- **Two pairs of trainers, one pair will get wet**
- **Hat**
- **Sun cream**
- **A complete change of clothes including underwear and socks**

Tuesday 25th June

A visit to Haigh Woodland Park They will be participating in High Ropes and Archery/Axe throwing.

They will need the following kit:

- **Old shoes/Trainers that can get wet and muddy**
- **Long sleeved top and an old hoodie/jumper**
- **Old trousers that can get wet and muddy**
- **Waterproof Jacket**
- **Gloves/sun hat/sun cream**

Packed lunches will be required for both these days in a plastic carrier bag and no glass bottles – Those who normally have a school meal can order one as normal on the day.
