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## YEAR 2 TRIP TO BLACKPOOL ZOO

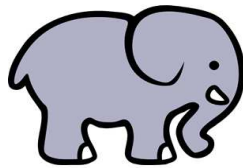
All- the children had a great time at the Zoo on the 12<sup>th</sup> December.
