At Westfield, we have always recognised the crucial role Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) education plays in the well-being and education of our children, it is an integral part of our curriculum, taught both as stand-alone lessons and through cross curricular learning.

The Department for Education announced changes to Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) following nationwide consultation. These changes came into effect from September 2020 and all schools are required to comply with the updated requirements.
