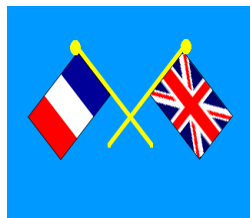

### Y5 TRIP TO WALKER ART GALLERY

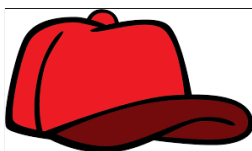
