Lailah 5W

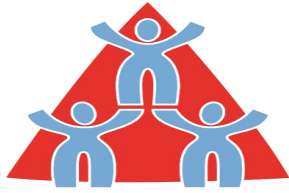
For working extremely hard right up to the end of term. Lailah has performed outstandingly this week, with tremendous scores in maths assessments and a brilliant hot task in writing

For a super week. Alfie has been focused and has worked well this week, showing us how mature and sensible he can be



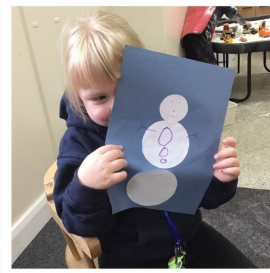
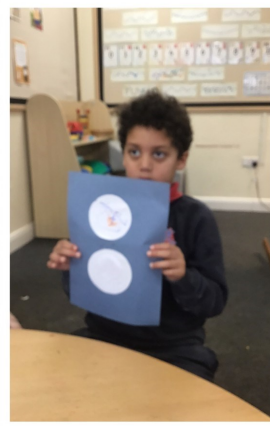
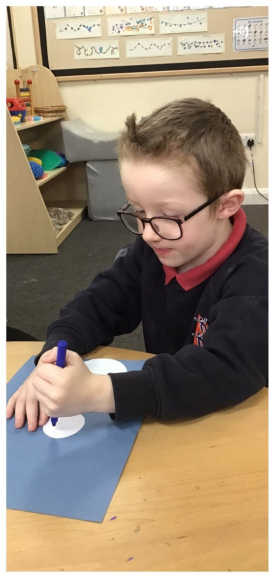
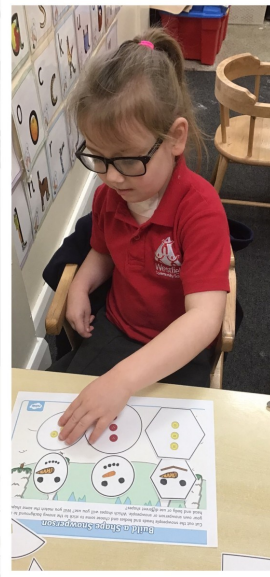

POD 1's topic to start the year is winter, so we have had snow themed activities this week.

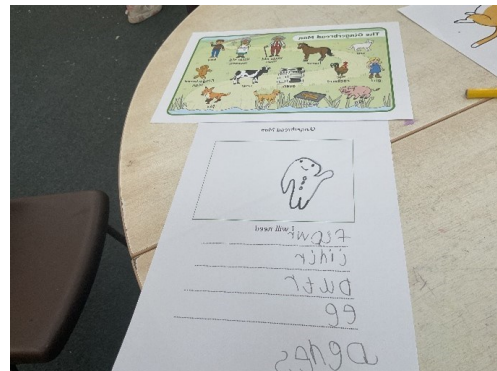

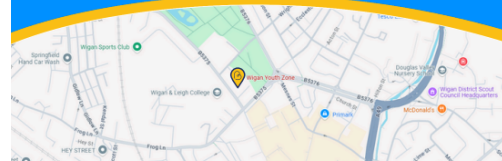
