Nikita 5W

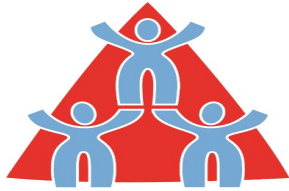
For working extra hard at home, resulting in amazing reading progress so far this year. Keep it up!

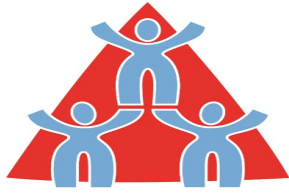

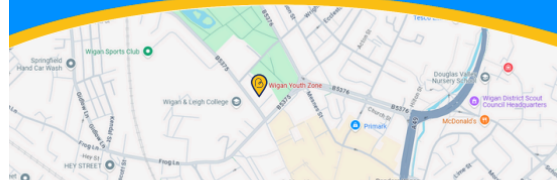
