Marnie 6F

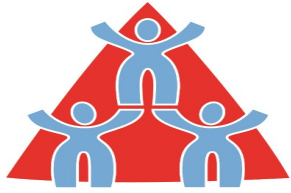
For the skill and accuracy shown when producing a scale drawing of a 6cm equilateral triangle
