*For her excellent attitude to learning*

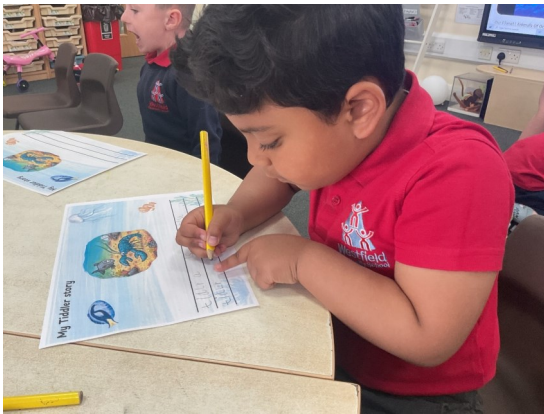


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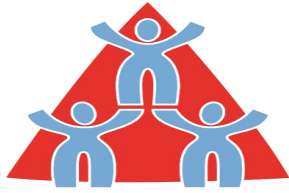
**REC & PODS**
