### **Lily-Lexi 5W**

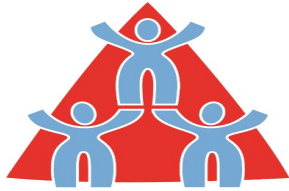
*For showing innovation, hard work and confidence when creating a model bird hide during our DT topic. Lily-Lexi thought outside the box to design and create a fantastic bird hide*

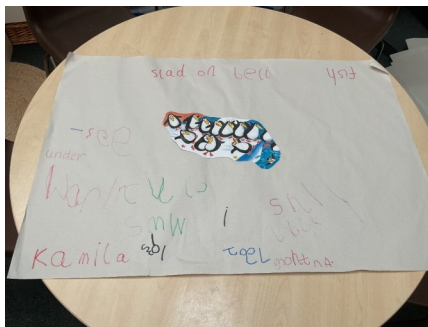

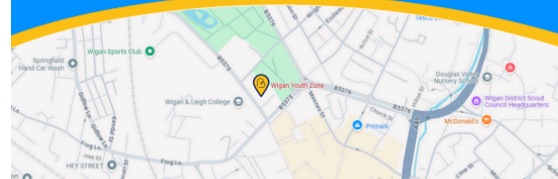
