Archie 6F

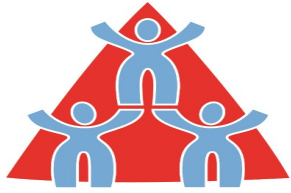

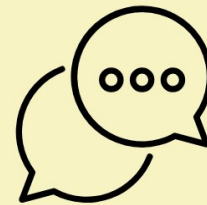
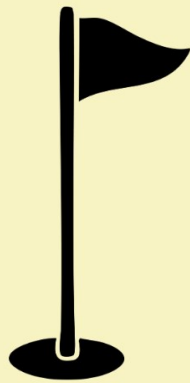
