Wigan Music services came to school to perform a 'Music Alive' assembly, showcasing string instruments to KS2. The children loved listening to the music and joining in with the songs.





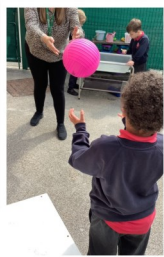
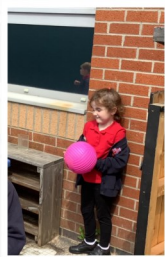
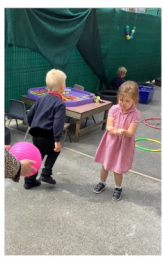
