Kaiya 5W

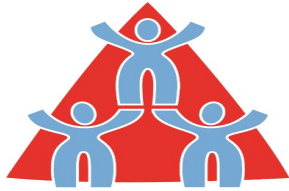
For being a kind, caring and patient shoulder partner, who works fantastically with those around her

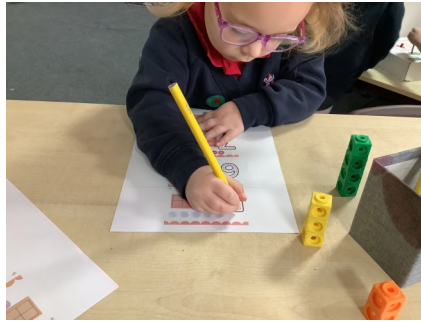
