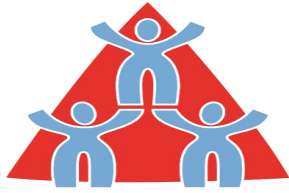

- Free bike checks and basic repairs

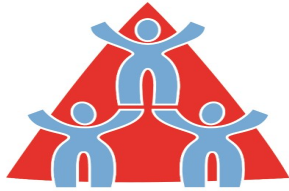
