We are hoping to raise as much money as possible, which will directly benefit the children and would appreciate support from parents and carers.

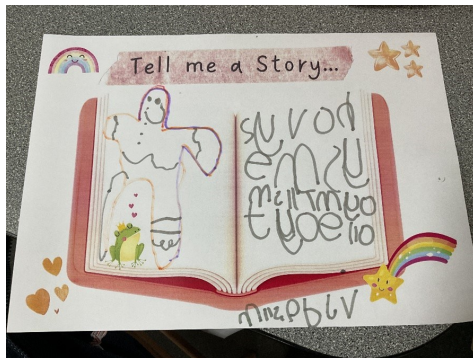

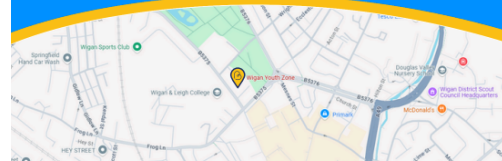
