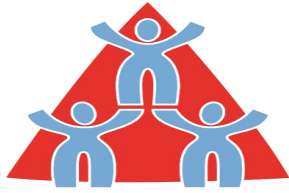
**Y6** enjoyed working in small groups this week to complete statistics problems and discuss their methods and steps to work the answers out.
